

## Master's in Theology major in Social Pastoral Communication (MAT-SPC)

MAT-SPC is linked with UST's Faculty of Sacred Theology. Students with a Bachelor's in Theology degree (BTh) or equivalent may acquire a Roman Licentiate (LTh) in addition to the MAT-SPC degree in the Graduate School.
